

# STOP-MOTION PUPPET RUBRIC

## Reflection

Heidegger and Derrida hold competing philosophies about the role of technology and its impact on art (or at least the art of writing and in comparison, art more broadly). What do you think of Heidegger and Derrida's arguments? If you were an art philosopher, what would you say about how technology is changing the art world and the kind of art that is made? Is technology a threat to craft? Is there such a thing as craft within a technological medium? Respond to these ideas by writing a reflection as if you were a philosopher of art, talking about the role of technology, craftsmanship, the hand-made, and possibly the death (and re-birth?) of hand-made.

In this section, you are not talking about your video as much as you are talking about these ideas generally. You are describing your point of view regarding the differing opinions of Heidegger and Derrida. You can use your video as an example for speaking about these ideas in general. Consider the following questions in your response.

1. What is the role of craftsmanship in art? Is it important? Why or why not?
2. How does technology interfere or support the idea of craft in artmaking?
3. Is technology changing the art world? If so, how? If not, why?
4. Is technology a threat to craft? If so, why? If not, why?
5. Should we value craftsmanship and hand-made objects as a society? Why or why not?
6. Do you appreciate art that is handmade less than, as much as, or more than art that is made using technology? Why?
7. Should we, as an American culture, value handmade things more than things made using technology?
8. Is there a distinction to be made about the difference between industry (things produced industrially) and technology (things produced using technological tools)? If so, why is that distinction important?

In a separate section, please discuss your feelings about the video you made, your successes and areas of growth, overall your experience of the assignment and how you would change the assignment if you had to do it again. Please also include what you learned from this project (knowledge, skills, techniques, etc.) that you would use on a future project.
