## 1. UNITY USING COLOR

In a tetradic color composition, create unity by repeating a color in different areas of the composition, linking those areas together.



## 2. UNITY USING SHAPE

In a split complementary color composition, create unity by repeating a shape in different areas of the composition, linking those areas together. You can use negative space or positive space versions of the shape in different sizes amongst other elements.



## 3. VARIETY & UNITY

In an analogous color composition, create variety by making different types of elements to add visual excitement to the composition. A well thought out composition has both variety and unity. Try to include unity as well.
